Storkeline

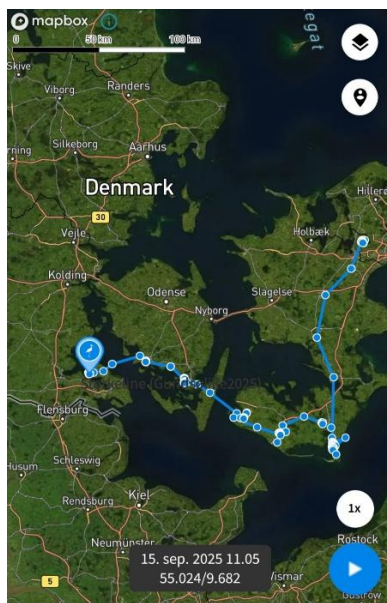
The female stork Storkeline is from the stork's nest in *Gundsøllille* west of Copenhagen on the island Zealand (Sjælland). In 2025 13 pairs of storks nested in Denmark. 12 pairs nests in Jutland and one pair nest on Zealand. 30 nestlings got on the wings in 2025. In *Gundsøllille* there were 3 nestlings that all got ringmarked and on 14/6 2025 Storkeline got an GPS attached . Since 2021 26 Danish youngstorks has got an GPS attached by the organization "Statens Naturhistoriske Museum" in Copenhagen" in cooperation with "Storkene.dk".



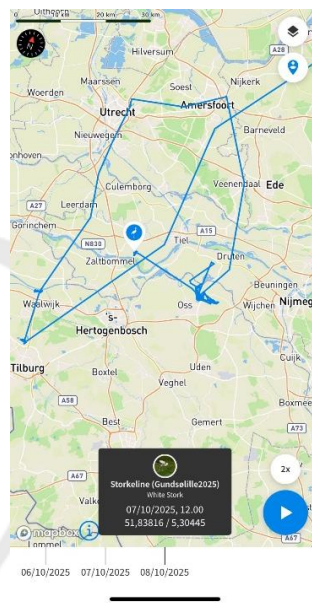

Migration

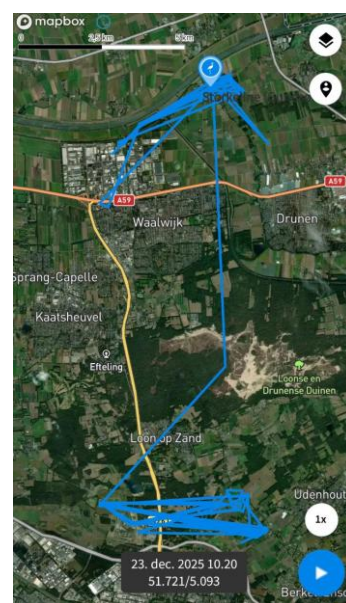
Storkeline and her two brothers made attempts to migrate from Zealand 17/8 and 7/9 but did not dare to fly over the Baltic Sea. On 21/9 Storkeline succeeded to migrate from Zealand over the islands Lolland, Langeland, Fyn to Als, very close to Jutland. From Jutland Storkeline went through Schleswig-Holstein, Niedersachsen to The Netherlands where she decided to hibernate in the area around *Waalwijk*. The adult storks in *Gundsøllille* origins from the Swedish storkproject and does not migrate. Therefore the youngstorks from this stork's nest had to migrate on their own without guidance of experienced storks.

Wintercount

Perhaps you will see Storkeline during your winter-stork-counting in The Netherlands. The GPS on Storkelines back looks like a black matchbox on the back of the stork. Just over the left foot a 3 cm high metal ring is to be seen.
